

Return to the full-time in-person teaching from week 6 of the summer semester 2021/22

This Dean's regulation is issued in accordance with the Methodical Instruction of the Vice-Rector for Pedagogical Activities for the continuation of teaching in the summer semester 2021/2022 (<https://aktualne.czu.cz/en> and other internal regulations, especially with valid CZU regulations on coronavirus (<https://aktualne.czu.cz/en/r-17100-current-measures>)).

1) Teaching conditions

- a) Since the epidemic situation is developing favourably and the conditions set by the Ministry of Health do not create obstacles for full-time (in-person) teaching, **with effect from 14 March 2022 all teaching at FEM CZU will be carried out in the normal mode in full-time (in-person) as well as in distant study. Lectures and seminars will take place in-person (face-to-face) with the joint presence of the students and teachers.**
- b) Teaching continues to be governed by the conditions set by the state administration. The basic requirement remains to ensure that teaching activities are carried out in their entirety and to the necessary quality, while minimising health risks.
- c) If the state authorities exclude the in-person attendance of the students in the teaching or the epidemic situation at CZU is unfavourable again, then it will be necessary to change into the hybrid or fully distant form of teaching again. The general distant teaching for the CZU is set by the Rector's orders on basis of the measures issued by the Government of the Czech Republic, the Ministry of Health, or on the basis of a specific legally binding anti-epidemic measure imposed on the university by the locally competent hygienic station. Another condition for distant teaching is also a valid decision of the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports on special authorizations of public and private universities in case of emergency.
- d) Exceptions from the in-person form of study are permitted exclusively by the Dean of FEM on the basis of a reasoned request. Exemptions granted under the previous regulation (No. 1/2022) remain in force.

2) Final provisions

- a) This Regulation shall enter into force on 14 March 2022
- b) On 14 March 2022 the Regulation No. 1/2022 expires
