The Faculty prefers electronic communication with the prospective students and it requires an electronically filled out application form to study in these programmes (http://is.czu.cz). When more applications for different study programmes are submitted, a **separate** fee of 850 CZK or 35 EUR must be paid for each application. It is not possible to use one single payment. Any application for which the fee is not associated with the correct payment information will be removed from the register. The fee is **non**-refundable at any stage of the admission process.

5) Preconditions for admission to the study programme are a successfully passed entrance examination and the proper completion of a bachelor study programme. Applicants must submit their university bachelor diploma on the day of registration (enrolment) to study. Under **no** circumstances can a student be enrolled without submitting their diploma. Applicants who have obtained their bachelor's degree in another country must also provide a document proving the nostrification of their education from a university accredited by the Czech Ministry of Education, or they may apply for an assessment of their foreign bachelor's degree as part of the admission process (Rector's Directive 2/2021).

Examination results are published on the notice board of the faculty within 7 working days of the examination at the latest, and are available in the e-application portal under results of the admission proceedings.

7) The fee for study – for students starting their studies in the academic year 2026/2027, the study fees for Master's programmes taught in English will be as follows:

A student who has not paid the tuition fee cannot be enrolled in the programme. By paying the



fee for study, the applicant confirms that they have thoroughly familiarized themselves with all the conditions to study in the Master's degree programmes ITB, EADAN, INFOAN, EMN and BAN taught in English and agree to them without any reservations.

The programme is opened only if a sufficient number of participants enroll.

8) Enrollment for newly accepted students will take place in June and July 2026. An alternative date for the enrollment will be set in September 2026.
