

## Organizing Admission Proceedings for the PhD SYII and SYEI Study Programmes in the Academic Year 2020/2021

In accordance with Article 49, paragraph 5, Act no. 111/1998 Coll. Tertiary institutions, and other laws as amended or updated, Faculty of Economics and Management of the Czech University of Life Sciences Prague hereby announces the following information concerning the organization of the admission proceedings for the PhD study programmes (DSP) Systémové inženýrství a informatika (SYII) and System Engineering and Informatics (SYEI).

### Admission Proceedings for SYII and SYEI DSP

#### Deadline for Admission Proceedings

Admission Proceedings for the above listed DSP will take place on **10 June 2020**. In serious cases, it is possible to attend the admission interview on an alternative date, which is 26 August 2020. The attendance on the alternative date requires the permission by the faculty dean, based on the candidate's application. Reasons for the necessity of attending on the alternative date must be given.

#### Submission of Application for Admission Proceedings

Applications are submitted online on <http://is.czu.cz>, as from **2 March 2020**. Deadline for submission of applications is **30 April 2020**. More information about how to fill the application can be found on the faculty's webpages in the *Science and Research* section (*Věda a výzkum*).

#### Conditions for Admission

Condition for admission of a candidate is passing the entrance exam, which comprises the following:

1. Specialised interview to assess the prerequisites for independent science and research activity and the knowledge of the specialized field based on the evidence of candidate's creative work.
2. Oral interview to determine the skills level of English and a second world language
3. University grades – arithmetic average of grading of all the subjects in the master type of study and/or in the last two years of a 5-year study programme.

On the basis of the entrance examination the admission committee will issue an evaluation of the candidate. This will include the statement recommending or not recommending the admission of the candidates into PhD studies.

## Decision on Admission and Contacting the Applicants

The decision on admission to study is made by the dean on the basis of (1) entrance exam result and (2) comments of the relevant department head. The applicant should receive information on the admission proceeding result within 15 days at the latest after the completion of the admission proceedings.

### Maximum permitted number of admitted students

The maximum permitted number of applicants to be admitted to PhD study programmes for academic year 2020/2021 are as follows:
