



Change in evidence of established credits and tests

Article 1

Introductory Provision

This regulation is issued in connection with the Dean's Decision No. 7/2020 and in accordance with the Study and examination regulations for study in the bachelor's and master's study programs of Czech University of Life Sciences Prague on 2 July 2019.

Article 2

Subject of the Decision

This regulation regulates the change of records for granted credits and examinations.

Article 3

Change in the Records of Granted Credits and Examinations

(1) In accordance with the Study and Examination Regulations for bachelor's and master's Studies study programs of the Czech University of Life Sciences Prague dated July 2, 2019 and in connection with the Dean's Regulation No. 7/2020 Change in the recording of records for granted credits and examinations performed in the academic year 2019/2020, with effect from September 29, 2020, I cancel the obligation to record the granting of a credit or an examination result to the study report. Credits and exams will continue to be entered only electronically into the CZU information system and will be kept in the records departments (record books).

(2) According to Article 8 Credits and examinations of the Study and Examination Regulations for study in bachelor 's and master's degree programs of the Czech University of Life Sciences Prague, completion of an exam, the examiner is obligated to, however no later than 3 working days after the day of completion of the exam, record the date of the test, by entering the relevant classification level according to paragraph 7 into the CZU information system. I also set this obligation for awarded credits and exams at the departments.

(3) In accordance with Article 21 Rights and obligations of students, paragraph 9, the student is required to monitor the records of their studies in the CZU information system, especially the status of their studies and results of their performed exams. In order to resolve any discrepancies, I stipulate the students obligation to resolve this immediately through the teacher of the subject, the guarantor of the subject, or the relevant Vice-Dean, no later than 10 working days from the time of the credit or examination.

Article 4

Final Provisions

(1) This regulation shall enter into effect on the date of its publication on the 29 September 2020.
