

Method and form of verification of study results (passing of credits and exams) at the Faculty of Economics and Management, ČZU Prague during the examination period of the winter semester of the academic year 2020/2021

Article 1

Introductory provisions

This regulation is issued in connection with the Rector's decision No. 30/2020 and in accordance with generally binding legal regulations, in particular with the extraordinary and protective measures of the Ministry of Health.

Article 2

Subject of the decision

This regulation modifies the method and form of verification of study results in the examination period of the winter semester of the academic year 2020/2021 at the Faculty of Economics and Management (hereinafter referred to as FEM) in connection with the restrictions caused by the Covid-19 pandemic.

Article 3

Method and form of verification of study results

(1) With regard to the current epidemic situation it is necessary to limit contacts with other persons within the pedagogical process, to the extent necessary.

(2) In the period from 2nd January to 7th February 2021 it is not allowed to take credits and exams from subjects in presence. During this period, it will be allowed to take credits and exams only in a distant form - via LMS Moodle, MS Teams, Google Meet or ZOOM application. This decision is made due to the current limitation of the number of people in physical form (it can also be expected to be tightened during January) which does not allow to open exam dates in physical form for all students and would violate the principle of equal approach. The decision was discussed and approved by the Board of the Dean of FEM.

(3) The possibilities of verifying the study results are regulated in more detail in the methodological instruction which is an appendix to the Rector's Decision No. 30/2020.

(4) Exceptions to paragraph (2) are available to doctoral students and students with disabilities. It also does not regulate the form of Final state examinations.

(5) Students are obliged to preferably use available tools that do not require a personal visit to the study office (e-mail, telephone) for handling their study matters.

(6) Students are required to follow current information regarding the conditions and organization of teaching (university e-mail, ČZU and FEM websites).

Article 4

Final Provisions

(1) This Regulation shall enter into force on the day of its publication and shall take effect on 21 December 2020.
