
Organization of the admission procedure for doctoral study programmes PEF in the academic year 2021/2022

In accordance with the provisions of Section 49, Paragraph 5 of Act No. 111/1998 Coll. About universities and about amendment of other laws Faculty of Economics, of the Czech University of Life Sciences of Prague publishes the following information related to the organization of the admission management into newly accredited doctoral study programmes (DSP) in year 2021, namely for DSP taught in the Czech language resp. in English:

- Podniková a odvětvová ekonomika,
- Management,
- Regionální a sociální rozvoj,
- Systémové inženýrství a informatika,

resp. in English:

- Sector Economics and Economics of Enterprises,
- Management,
- Regional and Social Development,
- System Engineering and Informatics.

Date of the admission procedure

The admission procedure to the above DSP will take place on **June 16, 2021**. In the case of serious reasons, it is possible to participate in the admission procedure in the alternative date that takes place on the 25th of August 2021. The Dean decides on the alternative date of the admission procedure at the request of the applicant, who is obliged to prove the need for a replacement date.

Submission of applications for the admission procedure

Applications are submitted via the internet application at <http://is.czu.cz>, starting **March 1st, 2021**. The deadline for applications is **April 30th, 2021**. More information to complete applications can be found on the faculty's website in *the Science and Research section*.

Conditions for admission

The condition for the admission of a candidate is the passing of an entrance examination, the content of which is:

1. Expert discussion assessing the preconditions for independent scientific and research activity and knowledge of the field on the basis of proof of own creative work applicants - for the purposes of the professional discussion, the applicant submits a written report of which the intention of the dissertation in the extent of a maximum of 1 page A4, no later than 7 days before the date of the entrance examination.

2. Oral interview verifying knowledge of English and a second world language.
3. Assessment of the results in the master's degree programme (or in the last two years in the case of a five-year study programme) based on the arithmetic average of all studied subjects.

Based on the entrance examination, the Admissions Committee will issue an evaluation of the applicant, inclusive opinions on whether it recommends accepting applicants for doctoral studies.

Decision to accept and notify candidates

The Dean of the faculty decides about the admission to study on the basis of (1) the result of the entrance examination and (2) the recommendation of the head of the relevant department. The applicants will receive the result of the admission no later than 15 days after the completion of the admission procedure.

Maximum number of accepted students

For the school year 2021/2022, the maximum number of students admitted to the doctoral study programs is determined as follows:
