
Changes in the organization of the Czech language examination in Bachelor study programmes at the Faculty of Economics and Management in the academic year 2021/2022

In connection with the current development of the COVID-19 epidemic, I am amending the Dean's Regulation No. 20/2020, which, in accordance with Sections 49 and 50 of Act No. 111/98 Coll., on Higher Education and on Amendments and Additions to Other Acts for Admission to Bachelor's Degree Programmes, announces the conditions for the organisation of the Czech language examination in Bachelor's degree programmes for the academic year 2021/2022 at the Faculty of Economics and Management of the Czech University of Life Sciences in Prague. The new wording of paragraph 3) is as follows:

3) Organisation and evaluation of Czech language examinations

Candidates must register for the exam independently. The application form is submitted electronically via the e-application system at <http://is.czu.cz/prihlaska>, after entering the application form, select the icon of the Faculty of Economics and Management, then select the type of study Lifelong Learning and select the desired date of the Czech language exam.

A fully completed application form including a receipt for payment of the fee of CZK 700 must be registered by the day of the language test. The specific date (room, time of the exam) will be communicated to the candidate in an electronic invitation to the exam via the e-application system at <http://is.czu.cz/prihlaska>. The fee for the language exam is 700 CZK and is non-refundable.

In view of the hygiene and epidemiological situation, the exam will be taken online. Successful completion of the exam means achieving at least 75% of the possible 100% points.

All communication, including the published exam result, is conducted electronically.

Proof of successful completion of the Czech language exam will be provided at the time of enrolment.
